1. Approval of Agenda

- 2.1. Educational Plan 2019-2022

2.2 Immersion Preschool

- Proposal is to move Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten to Immersion taught by Mme Doré and a teacher to be named later.
- 15 new students for Kindergarten in 2019-2020 + 12 coming from Pre-Kindergarten and 3 applications awaiting approval on special student status.
- Carol Clifton moves that in the 2019-2020 school year St Gabriel changes Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten classes to French Immersion. Seconded by Gloria Lombardi and approved with one abstention.

2.3 School Uniforms

- Jim Daskalakis explained the current policy.
- Governing Board discussed different options on sweatshirts.
- Governing Board agreed to a modified policy on uniforms which is:
 - 1. Crested royal-blue shirt
 - Optional navy-blue cardigan, sweater or sweatshirt over the royal-blue shirt.
 Sweaters, cardigans and sweatshirts may have a hood and must be solid navy-blue or black in colour.
 - 3. No logos or text other than those officially approved or supplied by the school may be worn.
 - 4. Choice of navy-blue or black pants, slacks, tunic, skirt, etc.
 - 5. Pre-Kindergarten students, while encouraged to follow the Dress Code, are officially exempt from it.

2.4 School Fees

- Jim Daskalakis outlined the current fees and recommends that the fees remain the same in 2019-2020.
- Governing Board approves to keep school fees the same in 2019-2020.
