Masks

Effective March 7, 2022 the wearing of a procedural mask will be mandatory for grades 1 to 6 students in common areas and on school transportation.

Students can take off masks in class when seated.

Masks must still be worn when circulating in the school, in the bus, during physical education and daycare.

Preschoolers do not have to wear masks in class or in school common areas, but those that take the bus must have a mask on in the bus.

Students do not have to wear masks in the lunchroom but as soon as they get up and start circulating masks must be worn.

Therefore, we will continue to issue two masks per student daily (one to come into the school and one to change after lunch).

ASSESS YOUR CHILD(REN)'S HEALTH.

In accordance with Public Health guidelines, individuals exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms must stay home and contact the COVID-19 info-line at 1-877-644-4545 and follow instructions. If symptoms develop do a Rapid Test and follow isolation procedure outlined by Santé Publique. Please also contact the school immediately to inform them.

That is, if your child has fever/chills, new or worsening cough, difficulty breathing, a sudden loss of sense of smell or taste without nasal congestion, new onset headache, new onset pain (muscular, chest, abdomen, joints), new intense fatigue, new severe loss of appetite, sore throat, vomiting or diarrhea, your child must stay home.

REPORTING ABSENCE DUE TO COVID

Parents can record any absence on the Mosaik App and can see daily, the reasons for absenteeism due to COVID related issues. This procedure allows parents to monitor any COVID related situations in their child's class. It began as of January 31, 2022. Parents must be registered with the Mosaik App.
