From the Dental Hygienist

Dental sealants will once again be offered free of charge at school! All Grade 2 students will receive a letter from the school dental hygienist regarding this.

What is dental sealant? Dental sealant is a material applied in a thin coating on the grooved surfaces of adult molars to reduce the risk of tooth decay. Adult molars are the large teeth at the back of the mouth. These teeth are considered to be at high risk of decay because it is harder for a child to reach them when brushing his/her teeth.
