Lunch Supervision Fees

Pre-Kindergarten-Grade 6 Lunch fees are 27.50\$ per month.

In order to assist our larger families, the maximum payment per family will be for two children.

School Fees

This fee is set at 25\$ per child for Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten. This cost includes an agenda and worksheets.

It is 60\$ per child for grades 1-6. This cost includes workbooks, an agenda and worksheets.

Grade 4 Hepatitis Vaccination

Students in Grade 4 will receive their first Hepatitis vaccination in the spring, it has been postponed.

DO NOT STOP AND PARK ON HALL STREET (ACROSS THE SCHOOL) IN THE MORNING TO DROP YOUR CHILDREN OFF FOR SCHOOL

Daily assessment of your child's health.

In accordance with new Public Health guidelines, individuals exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms can stay home and isolate until symptoms are gone for at least 24 hours.

Please contact the school administration to inform them.

That is, if your child has fever/chills, new or worsening cough, difficulty breathing, a sudden loss of sense of smell or taste without nasal congestion, sore throat, new onset headache, new onset pain (muscular, chest, abdomen, joints), new intense fatigue, new severe loss of appetite, sore throat, vomiting or diarrhea, your child stays home.

If child is symptomatic but does not have fever, they can attend school but with a mask until symptoms are gone.
