6. Principal's Report

The Principal presented the report.

1. Holiday dance approval, 2\$ per child for participation.

- 3. Scholastic bookfair raised 2k+, the school made 800\$ in scholastic \$ to be divided amongst teachers to upgrade their classroom libraries
- 4. Anti-bullying presentation to grade 6 students upcoming
- 5. K4 & K5 targeted for a workshop called kind kids, sensitivity and kindness workshop for the littlest ones.
- 6. Cycle 1 getting a self-regulation workshop offered by the same organization as the kindness workshop.
- 7. Friendship week is coming up end of February before March break - school looking at team building, external organization to do workshops.
 - PPO could assist during that day, to have parents volunteer, or give something back to the students during that time, specifically during the day of the carnival.
 - Date to be confirmed.
- 8. Yard space on Wellington street in response to indoor recess is almost ready, will be for K4, K5 and grade 1.
- 9. French afterschool tutoring with Miss Marisol to continue.
- 10. Update on open house was provided
 - Putting a list together of all activities being run by students in school, which could be put on the website to promote after school activities and life at school.
- 11. Update on budget:
 - They have received full budgets for specific budgets of the overall budgets. Supplies, library, furniture, etc. - all these envelopes have been received, representing 80% of last year's.
 - The principal is still being very conservative as expecting more expenses in the spring for activities, graduation, etc.
 - Still elements to be mindful of - technology, release teachers, release teachers for IEPs, etc. Being creative to work around these budgets has come through yet.
